Correllians around the World

in this series of articles, we are going to focus on a Correllian Member, and learn a little bit more about the said person. I do hope that this will shine a light to all of those, who are giving of themselves, to the Tradition.

This month, we are going to talk with Aria, or as she really is named: Maria Kopidaki, and are born and raised in Greece. She says that ‘nobody ever uses Maria, or even knows it, to be honest!’ She will be 29 this November (24/11/2021). Aria currently lives in Salamina island, Greece. They move a lot because of her husband’s work. She lives with her partner Manos, their puppy Nova (sweet baby-girl!), a turtle that they call “The Dinosaur” and their two rabbits – Ellie the Pookah and Princess Taz.

Aria was born and raised on the island of Crete, near the Palace of Knossos and she remembers having a figurine of the so-called “Snake Priestess/Goddess” as a child, that was so dear to her and she really wanted to be a priestess of the Great Mother (or Potnia) one day! As a teen she knew her beliefs were not the same as others’ (most people here are Christian Orthodox) and she tried to find her path. She read some things about Wicca in general –and she even started a Book of Shadows- but without committing to it (she was 14-15yo). Later, she studied Archaeology and Art History (BSc) and everything led her back to her path. She practiced solitary for a while and -when the time was right- she found her place in the Tradition.

As a person, Aria likes to travel and loves hiking! She believes that any time spend in nature is never lost! Her summers are usually spent on a beach or excavating archaeological sites (she loves the Minoan civilization, she feels that they are her ancestors). She has earned the Third degree in Usui Reiki and she works with crystals. Aria says she tries to learn as much as she can on every subject related to healing - mostly!! She also makes jewelry with crystals, that she believes help the owners a great deal!!

Aria does not have any favourite divination tool, but has tried to use tarot cards, once or twice. Aria found her way to Correllian Tradition, when she was searching for Greek pagan groups on Facebook, and she found one that had posts of the Correllian Temple “Serpent of Hermes”. She saw they were having guided meditations on the Five Elements and wanted to join. She participated and she has been with them ever since!! She has not been a member of the Correllian Tradition for more than about ten months, but it feels she has been in the family for years!!

Aria is a 1st Degree Dedicant, and she is an outer-court member of the “Serpent of Hermes”, the only Correllian Temple in Greece. She is also a member of the Order of Reiki. She plans on joining more after she complete her First Degree!! She has studied reiki and also some classes on the Witch School platform, but she is way in the beginning!!

Witches of British Folklore

The UK has a long history of witchcraft dating back to the middle ages, sometimes colourful, most times dark and gruesome. From this history the inevitable folk tales and legends are born, told alongside, or even evolving from, true events. In this new series each month I will look at historical events as well as legends that have defined the image of historical witchcraft in the minds of the people of the UK today.

The Legend of Mother Ludlam

This legend can be traced back to the 17th century and the village of Frensham in Surrey. The story goes that an ancient white witch known as Mother Ludlam lived in a cave nearby.



Mother Ludlam developed a reputation for lending local villagers anything they had need of. However, there was a proviso attached - anything they borrowed had to be returned to her within two days. Those needing assistance were required to stand on a boulder at the entrance to her cave and clearly state what they required. Once they got home they would then find the object of their desire waiting for them.

One day, a local man visited the cave and asked to borrow the witch's cauldron. At first she was reluctant to agree to his request. The cauldron was her personal property and she had need of it herself. Being a kindly soul, she eventually allowed him to take it, reminding him clearly of the obligation to return it within two days.



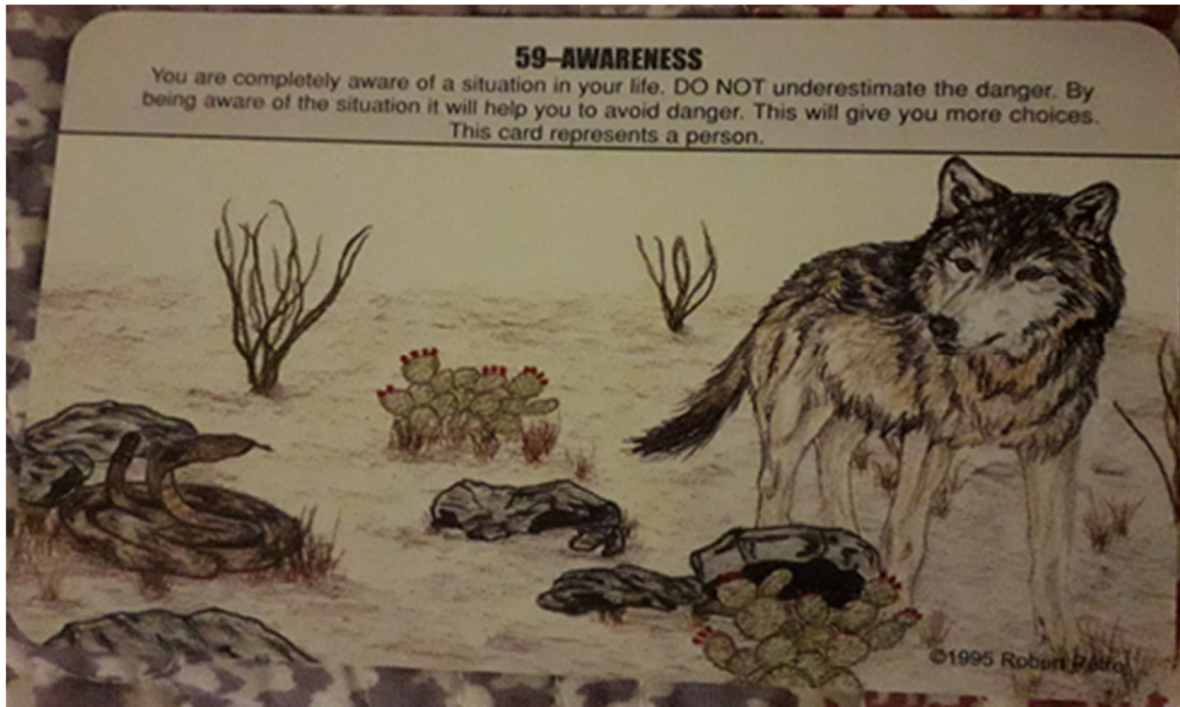
However, two days passed and her cauldron was not returned to her. She patiently waited but eventually, angry at this abuse of her kindness, she left her cave and went in search of the man. The man, terrified at forgetting to return her property within the given time limit, and well aware of her reputation as a witch, sought refuge in Frensham church, taking the cauldron with him.



Afraid of what the Church would do to her if they learnt she was a witch, she returned to her cave. The cauldron remains at Frensham church to this day. It has since been used for hundreds of years by the Frensham priests to brew their local ale, which they used at many a religious festival and was, as another legend says, responsible for many a sore head the next morning!

Festival Recipes by Rev. Bella

Recipe for Lammas - Northern hemisphere

Corn Fritters written by Tania Sheff @cooktoria.com

INGREDIENTS

- ½ cup all-purpose flour
- 1 egg
- ¼ cup water
- 1 tsp. baking powder
- 1 tbsp. olive oil
- 1 cup corn kernels fresh or canned
- 1 medium bell pepper seeded and diced
- ¼ cup chopped parsley
- ¼ cup chopped chives
- ½ tsp. salt or to taste
- ½ tsp. pepper or to taste
- olive oil for frying about 3-4 tablespoons



INSTRUCTIONS

Prepare the batter by whisking together the flour, baking powder, egg, and water in a medium bowl. When the batter is smooth, add the olive oil, salt, and pepper and mix well.

To the batter, add the corn, bell pepper, parsley, and chives. Mix it well and set aside.

Heat up a large, non-stick skillet over medium heat. Pour about 3-4 tablespoons of olive oil onto it. Once the oil is hot, add one heaping tablespoon at a time of the corn mixture, and flatten out the tops slightly to make the fritters even. Cook for 3-4 minutes per side, or until golden brown.

Serve these fritters with a fresh salad on the side for a filling and healthy lunch. Or serve these as a snack with a dipping sauce on the side. Here are some dipping sauce ideas:

Tzatziki (Low Fat Yogurt & Cucumber Dip) , Copycat Outback Bloom Sauce , Cilantro Jalapeno Sauce, Yogurt or Sour Cream

INGREDIENTS

- 6 Potatoes
- 1/2 cup butter
- 1/3 cup flour
- 4 cups milk
- 1 cup sour cream



INSTRUCTIONS

Pierce potatoes with a fork; microwave on high for about 20 mins, turning potatoes over halfway thru. Peel and cube potatoes. Mash 3 of the potatoes leaving 3 cubed and set aside.

Whisk butter and flour in a saucepan over low heat until smooth and thick. Whisk in milk and whisk until thickened. Heat over medium heat for 5-10 minutes more. Be careful not to burn.

Add in the potatoes; stir in sour cream. Simmer, without boiling until heated thoroughly.

Transfer to slow cooker and keep on low or warm all day.

Serve this soup with a salad and bread for a complete meal. Top with crumbled bacon and shredded cheese to make it extra yummy!

Wolfciara's Wiccan World

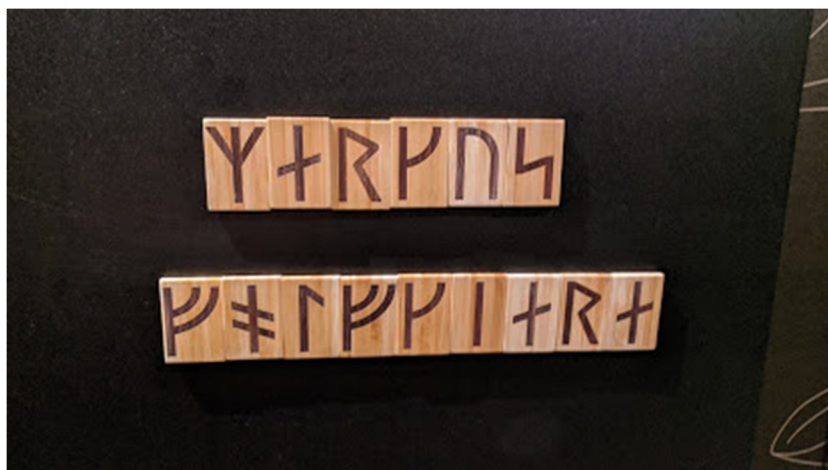

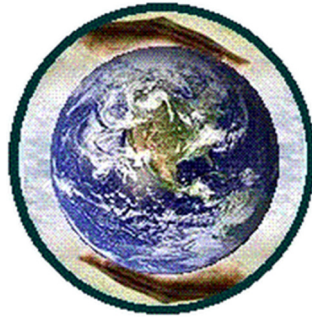

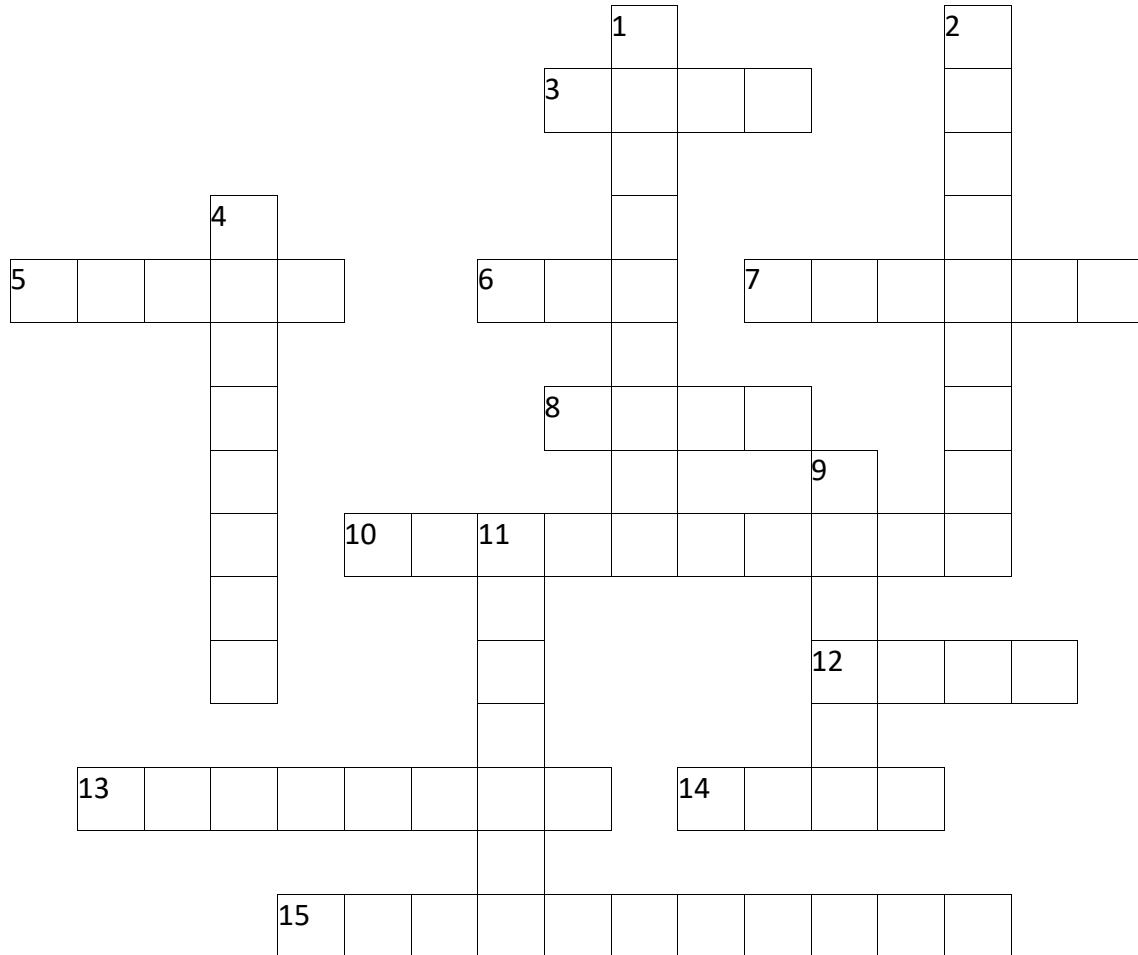

Witan Shrines are the first level of the Temple-Making Process. Witan Shrines are created by Charter of the Tradition and may progress to Full Temple status over the course of several years or remain at Witan Shrine status indefinitely.

Proto-Temples are groups which have progressed beyond the status of Shrines and are on their way to becoming Full Temples but have not yet achieved that status.

Full Temples of the Correllian Tradition have completed the Temple-Making Process and, if headed by a Third Degree, have representation on the Witan Council. A Full Temple can perform all of the functions of a Temple and may in some cases have multiple branches.
