#### **Witches of British Folklore**

The UK has a long history of witchcraft dating back to, sometimes colourful, most times dark and gruesome. From this history the inevitable folk tales and legends are born, told alongside, or even evolving from, true events. In this new series each month I will look at historical events as well as legends that have defined the image of historical witchcraft in the minds of the people of the UK today.

# The Witches of Pendle

Ten people were charged with witchcraft and sentenced to death in August 1612. A nine-year-old girl was the key witness in the case, and as a result of her testimony several people were executed - including her own mother, sister and brother.



The witch hunting frenzy began after James VI, king of Scotland, went to Denmark to marry his Dutch bride. Denmark had a long history of witch hunts and witch trials, and James became obsessed with finding witches when he visited the country. When he returned to Scotland with Anne, they were caught in a terrible storm, which James interpreted as a sign that a witch had tried to murder the king and his new queen.

The first victim was Agnes Sampson, whose ghost, dubbed 'Bald Agnes,' is said to haunt Holyrood Palace and is thought by some to be the inspiration for Shakespeare's Weird Sisters in *Macbeth*.

James brought his suspicions with him when he became king of England. He had already written a book about the importance of seeking out witches, known as the *Deamonologie*. Though less brutal than the *Malleus Maleficarum*, which was published in Germany 110 years before, it was still a dangerous book that led some, including the man who would later be known as the Witchfinder General, Matthew Hopkins, to believe that they had the right to accuse and torture their neighbours until they admitted to the charges against them.

Although James advocated punishment only for the guilty, he had already spread fear by setting an example of what a witch hunt looked like, and by torturing so many people himself. The *Deamonologie* emphasised the significance of persecuting witches in a Christian society.

One of the most important items for me in my witchcraft, is my Book of Shadows. Even if I have trouble with how to fill it.


I wanted one that had to look a specific way with specific colours and paper. So I went on a course to try and make my own but I totally failed. It was a disaster.

And I was a bit sad that it looked so plain and dull with no colours or anything pretty.




This is an example of the text for my Ogham runes I wrote about some time ago.


Because I always get so many ideas, I thought why not make the documents on the computer, print them out and then glue them into my Book of Shadows.

I started out by changing all 13 Ogham trees, made the documents on the computer and have now glued them into my book. Next, I will do the same with the runes.





Now I think that my book will be a combination of both handwriting and printed documents.

## **The Pentacle Through History**

Modern pagans use the pentacle as a symbol of their faith and unfortunately many non pagan people look down on the symbol believing it to represent evil, magic and even the devil. Little do they know the pentacle is older than any religion practiced by humans today. The pentacle was already present in Sumer, Babylon, Egypt, ancient Greece as well as ancient China (770-476 BC), Japan, India, and Central America with the Mayans. The pentagram itself is even seen on many national flags around the world and often in Freemasonry as well. The idea of the pentacle being an evil symbol is a very new idea in the history of man. It started in the Middle Ages with the persecution of pagans, witches and any other groups that threatened the Catholic church of the time, including freemasons. Satanism did not even exist until the 1960s. I would like to present the history and evolution of the pentacle to show why the symbol is an excellent representation of the pagan faith and that there is absolutely nothing evil about it.

#### **Sumer and Babylon**

In Mesopotamia in the area known as Sumer, the first evidence of pentagrams was found on pottery shards, cuneiform tablets and on pylons near main gates. It is believed the symbol represented UB meaning corner or angle.

During the Babylonian times, the pentagram evolved to represent the 5 visible planets that are observable with the naked eye (Mars, Mercury, Venus, Jupiter and Saturn). It also represented the planet Venus as well as the Akkadian goddess Inanna and the Sumerian goddess Ishtar. This is likely where the planet Venus was associated with femininity and probably the origin of the Greek goddess Venus.

#### **Egypt**

Ancient Egypt marks a turning point in the history of the pentagram in the fact that it was during this time that there is evidence of the pentagram representing the five elements and thus the idea of eternal life. Many pagans today recognize that many concepts present in magic today began in Egyptian times and possibly earlier but the Egyptians were the first to record this information. The Egyptians also recognized the symbolic union of man and woman within the pentagram. What better symbol to represent the elements of which all life is created as well as eternal life and continual creation through the union of man and woman? The Egyptians drew a circle around the pentagram in the form of a snake to represent the eternal shedding of the snake like the solar cycle of the year. In this way the snake represents the sun god.

#### Greece

In ancient Greece, the pentagram represented the golden ratio which is found in all of nature. It is the perfect representation of this concept and the pentagram is divisible to infinity if we could see infinitely small particles. The pentagram represented perfection that is even found in the human body with a man in starfish position forming a perfect pentagram. The word SALUS is found around many Pythagorean pentagrams which means health. This makes you wonder if Chinese Medicine influenced the Greeks with the Silk Road exchanges because the Chinese believed that when all 5 elements or organs were balanced, a man would be in good health. For Pythagoras the pentagram represented the 5 elements which made up man himself but also all of life. Ancient Greeks still saw the pentagram as representing the 5 visible planets as well but the mathematical perfection of the symbol came to light during this time of mathematical and scientific development. The golden ratio is seen everywhere in Greek architecture and sculptures as well as artwork completed by classical masters.

#### **China and Japan**

It is highly likely that the pentagram symbol was imported to China with the Silk Road when many merchants traveled between Europe and Asia. The Chinese saw the symbol as a perfect representation of the elements and the idea of unity. Chinese elements as seen in Traditional Chinese Medicine are Fire, Earth, Metal, Water, and Wood. Pentagrams were used in Chinese Medicine to represent the natural cycles of creation but also of destruction. A perfect example of Yin and Yang in the balance between life and death and the interrelation of all the elements of

which all the material world is made. Each point of the star represents an element and the circle that connects them represents the union of the 5 elements which create life. The pentagram design formed from connecting the points with straight lines represents the cycle of destruction, which is not considered an evil or negative idea in Asian cultures but a necessary part of life. Science tells us matter is neither created nor destroyed but only transformed. This is the same concept in the idea of the cycle of creation and of destruction. All things must eventually die to allow other things to be created. When we believe in an eternal soul, this is not an injustice nor a horrible thing to think of. Therefore, the pentacle represents a perfect balance and the higher truth of nature and life. There is no better symbol that exists to represent as fully this idea.


The pentagram and pentacle are found in occultism all over Asia but the better known uses are seen in Chinese Medicine and in Japanese Shintoism. Shintoism is still practiced today at different degrees in Japan but the pentacle is a symbol used in Shinto ritual and is present on Shinto shrines and especially their gateways. It is a sacred symbol representing the divine and can be seen as a symbol of protection. Asian occultism has many similarities with Western occultism and it is not always clear as to whether the East imported Western magic or whether the West imported Eastern magic. Possibly both cultures exchanged magical concepts which is why there are many similarities today.

#### India

Hinduism uses the pentacle much the same way as in Chinese Medicine to represent the goddess Kali which is the goddess of destruction and creation. She represents eternal life. As said before the circle connecting the elements is creation whereas the pentagram is the cycle of destruction. This can be explained as Fire engenders Earth, Earth engenders Metal, Metal engenders Water, Water engenders Wood and Wood engenders Fire. This creates a circle like the one below



The cycle of destruction is then illustrated by creating a pentagram between the elements. This can be explained by Wood splits the Earth by growing vegetation, Earth absorbs Water, Water puts out Fire, Fire melts Metal and Metal chops Wood. Therefore, the pentagram illustrates this process of destruction so that the cycle of creation can continue. Ayurvedic medicine and yoga are based on the same concepts of Chinese medicine and Qi Gong. An illustration of the Chinese pentacle used in India as well is pictured below.



#### **Central America**

The pentacle was found in ancient Mayan ruins and is curiously similar to the pentacle of ancient Mesopotamia and Egypt. Another interesting point is the Mayan pyramids that strangely resemble the Sumerian ziggurats and the Egyptian step pyramids. Their god was a feathered serpent named Quetzelcoatl who was just like the rival god Apophis of Amen Ra that battled him every night under the earth (opposite side of the earth). Evidence of cannabis being used in embalming rituals of Egypt also makes one believe there was exchange of some sort between Central America and Mesopotamia at some point. Venus represented the Mayan god Quetzelcoatl and the pentagram is a representation of Venus.

#### **Modern Influences**

The pentagram is seen today on national flags around the world and each of these countries were influenced at some point by these ancient cultures. The pentagram was not always a negative symbol and has become so overtime with the persecution of pagan cultures with the rising of the Catholic church in the Middle Ages and much later because of satanism that was a popular movement in the 1950s and 1960s with the pentagram of Baphomet representing the 1<sup>st</sup> wife of Adam, Lilith whom Adam rejected because she would not submit to him. She then copulated with demons which gave rise to the evil of the world. The story of Lilith is old but the concept of the devil is a new idea that came from Christianity and devil worship is even newer dating to the past century. Before Christianity, the pentagram and pentacle always had positive meanings and were even used for protection and represented all that is divine.

The "book religions" or Christianity, Judaism and Islam all used the pentagram at one point to represent the 5 wounds of Christ, the 5 books of the Torah and the 5 pillars of Islam.

Freemasons use the pentagram and pentacle as sacred geometry in that it represents the divine or golden ratio and is therefore a perfect representation of the divine architecture of God. Freemasons are historically masons and geometry is the center of everything in masonry. Only through geometry and perfect ratios could the masons build cathedrals so huge and so high in stone. The pentagram is seen in many creations of freemasons whether in buildings or in artwork as many members of freemasonry were artists.

Modern witchcraft and Wicca use the pentacle as a symbol of their faith today and a very good choice it is as it represents the history of man and was present in almost all ancient religions as an important representation of life. For us Wiccans the pentacle represents the divine feminine, the elements, the union of man and woman, eternal life through a continual cycle and therefore all that represents life, death and the divine within us all. It is a symbol of unity, balance, protection and eternal life because all is goddess and goddess is all.

## **Festival Recipes**

## Recipe for Samhain, Northern Hemisphere

Brie + Cheddar Apple Beer Soup with Cinnamon Pecan Oat Crumble written by halfbakedharvest.com

### **INGREDIENTS:**

Cheddar Apple Beer Soup with Brie

- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 sweet onion chopped
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 2/3 cup apple cider
- 2 small Honeycrisp apples or 1 large, chopped
- 2 teaspoon fresh thyme chopped (or 1/2 teaspoon dried)
- 1 (12 ounce) beer I used pumpkin beer
- 2 cups low-sodium chicken broth
- 1/4 teaspoon cayenne pepper
- 1/4 cup flour
- 1 cup whole milk
- 1 cup shredded sharp cheddar cheese
- 8 ounces brie rind removed + cubed







#### Cinnamon Pecan Oat Crumble

- 1 cup old fashioned oats
- 1 1/2 cups whole raw pecans
- 2 tablespoons flour
- 2 tablespoons brown sugar
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- 6 tablespoons unsalted butter

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

#### To make the Crumble

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F.

Working on a greased cookie sheet or pyrex dish, add the oats, pecans, flour, brown sugar, cinnamon and salt.

Add the softened butter and use your fingers to crumble it into the oats mixture until everything is moist and the butter is evenly distributed.

Bake for 20 minutes, stirring halfway through cooking, until crisp is golden brown and smells amazing.

#### To make the Soup

Heat a large soup pot over medium heat. Add the olive oil. Once hot, add the onions and a pinch of brown sugar. Season with a little salt and pepper. Cook about 5 minutes, stirring frequently, until softened.

At this point, slowly add in the apple cider, let it cook into the onions, add more and continue to cook. Do this until the onions are caramelized. Add the apples and thyme to the pot and cook over medium heat, stirring, until softened, 8 minutes.

Add in any remaining apple cider, the beer, chicken broth and cayenne. Bring to a simmer and cook 5-10 minutes or until the apples are tender. (This is when I bake the crumble) Meanwhile, whisk the flour into the milk until smooth. Set aside.

Once the apples are soft, puree the soup until chunky smooth or completely smooth (whatever you like). Return the soup to the stove and bring to a low bowl. Whisk in the milk mixture and boil until the soup thickens slightly, about 5 minutes.

Stir in the cheddar cheese and brie until melted and smooth. Simmer the soup 5 minutes or until ready to serve.

Ladle the soup into bowls and top with the cinnamon pecan crumble. Plus maybe some extra cheese too!!

# Recipe for Beltaine, Southern Hemisphere

Dandelion Salad (from eatsmarter.com)

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 150 grams dandelion greens
- 2 nectarine
- 1 small pear
- 250 grams buffalo mozzarella
- 4 tablespoons olive oil
- 3 tablespoons dark balsamic vinegar
- 180 grams coarse sea salt
- freshly ground peppers



#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

Rinse the dandelion greens and pat or shake dry.

Rinse the nectarines and the pear, remove the seeds and cores and cut into very thin columns. Cut the mozzarella into pieces.

Arrange the dandelion greens, the fruit and the cheese on a plate and drizzle with olive oil and balsamic vinegar. Distribute the ham on top and serve seasoned with salt and pepper.

Suggestion: serve with some fresh ciabatta.





#### **Chartered Bodies of the Correllian Tradition**

<u>Witan Shrines</u> are the first level of the Temple-Making Process. Witan Shrines are created by Charter of the Tradition and may progress to Full Temple status over the course of several years or remain at Witan Shrine status indefinitely.

<u>Proto-Temples</u> are groups which have progressed beyond the status of Shrines and are on their way to becoming Full Temples but have not yet achieved that status.

<u>Full Temples</u> of the Correllian Tradition have completed the Temple-Making Process and, if headed by a Third Degree, have representation on the Witan Council. A Full Temple can perform all of the functions of a Temple and may in some cases have multiple branches.
